#### Savory Reward Levels & Gifts

**500 points** = Complimentary cocktail or glass of wine for 2 from our by the glass selection.

**750 points** = \$50 4th & Swift Gift Card.

**1,500 points** = Complimentary bottle of wine from our extensive wine collection (value not to exceed \$100).

**2,500 points** = "Savory Romance" – Romantic Dinner for two paired with wines (alcohol, tax and gratuity not included).

## Savory Rewards Terms & Conditions:

A completed member profile is required before the 4th & Swift Savory Rewards Card is issued.

Use of the card constitutes acceptance of the terms and conditions.

Points are accumulated at the rate of 1 point for \$1.00 spent on food and beverages [excluding tax and gratuity], gift cards and private dining events.

The Savory Rewards card cannot be redeemed for cash or replaced if lost, stolen or used without your permission, nor are they transferable.

Points have no cash value and may not be redeemed for cash. Cards are valid for all purchases, but may not be used for tax, gratuity, or to exchange for cash.

Points are credited to your account when presenting your Savory Rewards card to your server at the restaurant.

Only the member paying the bill may accumulate points. Points are non-transferable.

Members cannot get credit for visits prior to enrollment in the Savory Rewards Program.

Points may be accumulated for a business entity. Accounts will be audited monthly and inactivated if fraud is suspected.

Federal and State tax liabilities are the responsibility of the cardholder. Laws may prohibit accumulation of points from alcohol purchases only.

Any errors on guest check receipt must be adjusted on the day the transaction was made.

Members must be 18 years of age or older. And 21 in order to redeem alcohol rewards.

Accounts will be deactivated if not used within 18 months.

Savory Hospitality Management may cancel this program at any time.

Accumulated points are not member property and may be revoked, cancelled, limited, or modified at any time, even though such action may affect the member's right to use previously accumulated points.

Savory Hospitality Management is not liable for points or awards lost due to fraudulent or unauthorized use, including fraud caused by lost or stolen cards.
